Never Stop...

I went back to school at 66. I was tied for the oldest student in the program. I went back, not because I needed more letters behind my name. But because something inside me whispered, You're not done yet.

So, I enrolled in a Graduate Certificate program in Executive Coaching through Royal Roads University in Victoria, BC. It was intense. After years away from classrooms, I had to wrestle with technology, such as learning platforms. Yet, it turned out to be one of the best decisions I've made in a long time.

Here's why: growth isn't just lifelong, it's life-wide. Yes, we grow over time. But we also grow across every dimension of who we are: spiritually, professionally, relationally, and emotionally. If only one part of us develops, the rest falls behind. Life-wide learning keeps us balanced and reminds us we're still becoming who we're meant to be. The challenge? Comfort zones. They look wise and whisper: You've done enough. You have nothing to prove. But growth doesn't care how many candles are on the cake. It only asks: Are you willing to keep learning? I was. And it changed everything

A New Role, A New Adventure

That "yes" opened a door. Today, I serve part-time as a Leadership Development Coach with the Saskatchewan Mennonite Brethren (SKMB). So far, walking alongside pastors and leaders seeking to support them in their own journeys has been deeply rewarding.

The funny thing about growth is that new invitations will appear once you lean into it. I never pictured this role years ago. Even a year earlier, it
