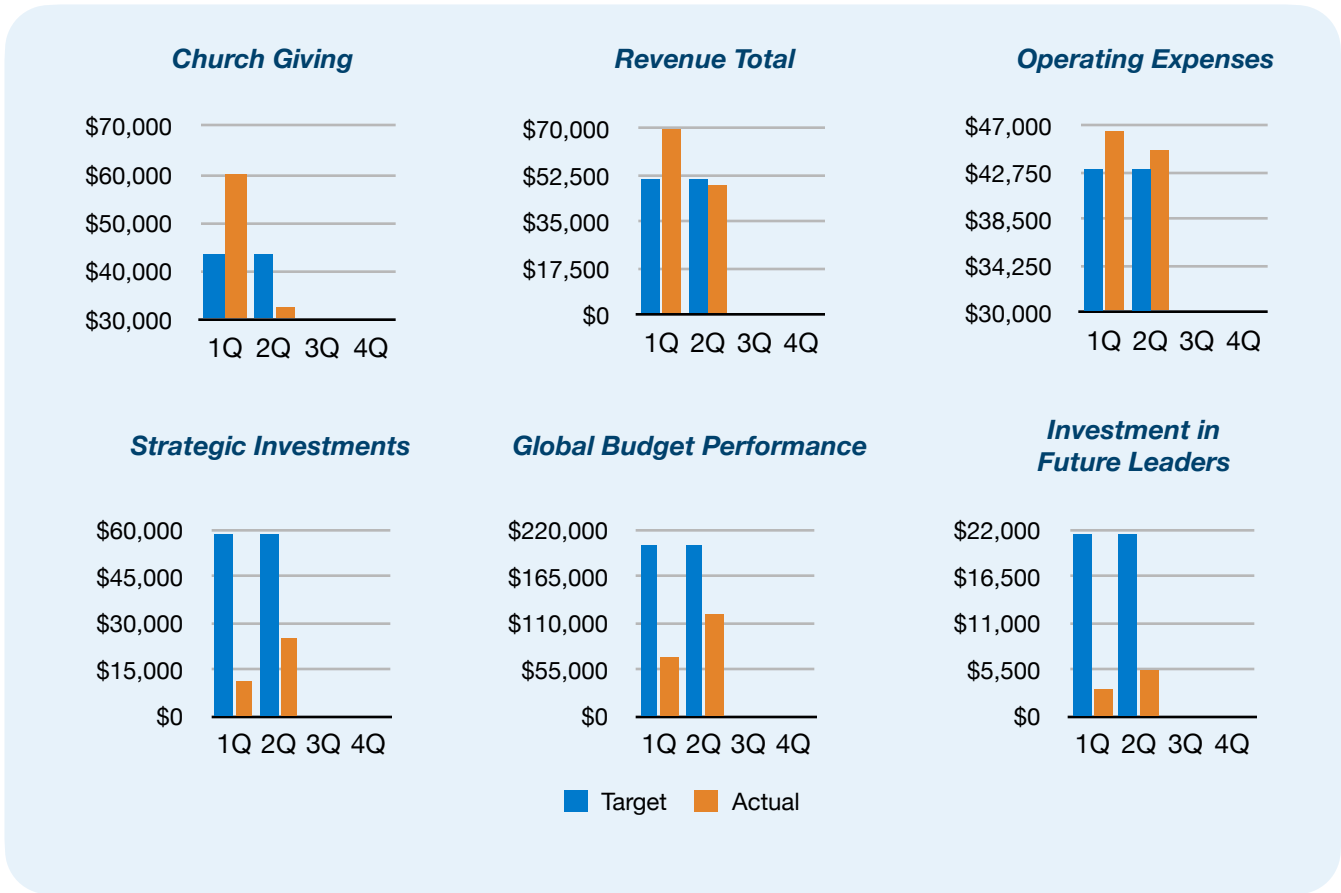


Financial Update
