



**Revenue From Churches**




**Revenue Total**

## News From The Executive Board

- To inspire and support churches in church planting
- To act as an informational hub for church planting initiatives

## How have your SKMB donations been invested?

As the SKMB executive Board, our goal is to ensure that your financial gifts are invested wisely and strategically in our mandate of supporting SKMB churches and camps in making disciples. We would like to take this opportunity to share some of the investments we have so far made on your behalf in 2018:

- Directory of Ministry: Phil Gunther's ministry to our churches and camps includes everything from inspiring the SKMB family through preaching and writing, supporting churches and camps through personal visits, calls, emails and other forms of communication, and resourcing our SKMB family by offering resources like *Inspiration Saskatchewan*, *Preaching Sabbatical*, *Discovery*, assistance with pastoral transition, conflict resolution and ministry counselling.
- Educational and internship bursaries for students and pastors.
- Sponsorship of pastors to attend the Pastoral Credentialing Orientation.
- Salary support for Mission Pentecostal Church (Regina), one of our new SKMB members. MPC is a new Canadian congregation which reaches out to those from African countries settling in Regina.
- Church support for a congregation facing a difficult time financially in their life.
- Inspirational Training: Thrive 2018 "Maintaining a Healthy Ministry" (April) and Talking & Prayer Circle "Seeking the heart of the Creator for Saskatchewan" – Indigenous Ministry (June).
- Grant to SOAR 2018 program - Discipleship for youth. (\$2500)
- Camp grants to Redberry and West Bank (\$5000)
