



Revenue From Churches




Revenue Total




Operating Expenses

SKMB Sends \$5000 To Quebec

This summer the SKMB Executive Board was asked if they could send financial support to École de théologie évangélique du Québec (ETEQ). Several factors caught the school in significant need of funds to carry on its ministry of training men and women to serve Christ in their communities. In the spirit of our new Canadian M.B. collaborative model, the Executive Board sent \$5000 to the school and identified it as an SKMV strategic investment.

ETEQ is a school located in Montreal and is rooted in the ongoing collaborative effort of evangelical churches to provide university-level theological education. ETEQ's purpose is to equip Christ followers to serve Christ in the ever-changing context of Quebec and the world.

ETEQ's founders are the Mennonite Brethren and the Christian and Missionary Alliance denominations. The school has more than 50 years of experience in equipping people to serve in their communities in the name of Christ.

ETEQ is a healthy, growing, French-speaking school with more than 50 years of history. Today, they serve about 70 students a semester in French. At both the undergraduate and graduate levels, they prepare believers to think, love and serve God. All ETEQ's students receive their diplomas or degrees from Université Laval, the school's provincial university partner.
