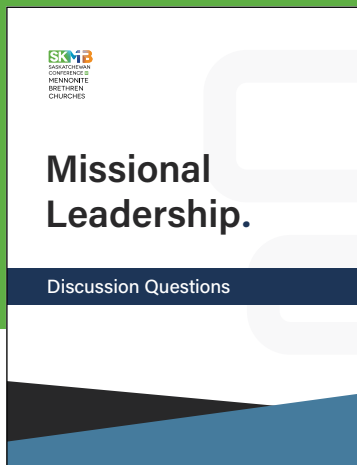

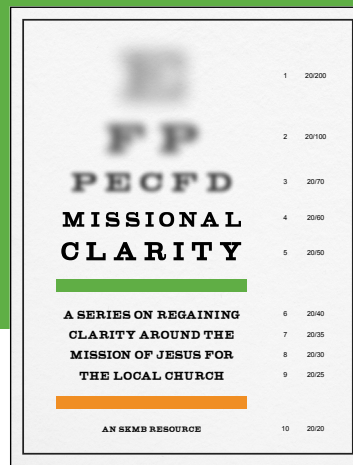

## Missional Leadership

The Missional Leadership series was created to help you and me as leaders push against missional drift. The reality is, as leaders there are two frontlines we are fighting missional drift on. There's the frontline of our heart and our own personal relationship with Jesus and the drift we can experience there. There is also the organizational frontline that we as leaders find ourselves on. In both context, drift happens and when it happens, it doesn't lead us closer to Jesus but further away, and the reality is no leader and no church is immune from it.

This series is designed to help us on both those fronts. It is there to help us as leaders ask some questions around our hearts and leadership but also around the church and where it is going? This is important for us because everything we do as leaders flows out of our relationship with Jesus and as we seek to have healthy churches, we must start with looking at having healthy leaders.



## Missional Clarity

The Missional Clarity series is meant to do one of two things for your leadership team:

1. This series is meant to help you ask that all important question, "Do we have missional clarity?" As you go through it as a team, it will either encourage you in what you are already doing as a team and church and maybe even help your missional focus grow stronger, or it might reveal to you that you have lost sight of the mission of Jesus and you didn't even notice it and it will help you take steps towards moving back towards clarity.
2. Maybe you know as a church you have lost sight of the mission. This series is to help you regain clarity on the mission. As you go through this series, you will have the chance to ask where and why you lost sight of the mission, and see some very practical steps you can take to begin to move the church back towards it.



## Leadership Greenhouse

In the past, other institutions like Bible Schools or Denominational programs carried the weight of leadership development, and our churches reaped the rewards of pre-made leaders. I don't say this in judgment but in thankfulness to these insinuations that have not only played a huge part in my development but have blessed the local church for many decades. But the reality is that the days of pre-made leaders have come to an end, and as we look ahead to the future of the church, one of the most valuable skills we can develop is an intentional leadership development process.

This series is designed to give you a foundation to build an in-house leadership development process that will fit your unique ministry context. To be clear, there is a lot of work that you and the team you are a part of will need to do to build a leadership development process within your church, but this series is somewhat like the blueprints to help guide you as you build.
